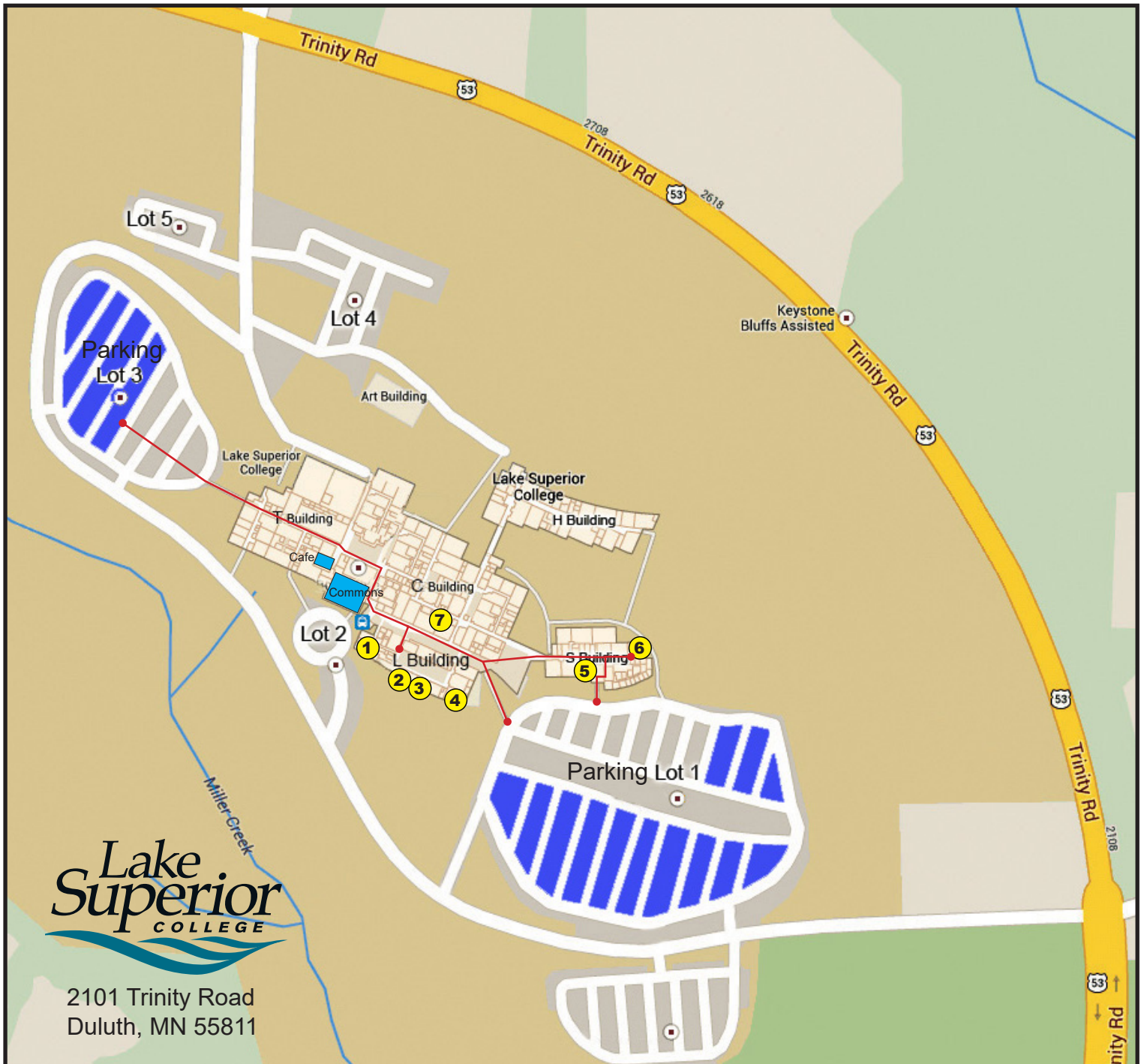
Classes are held at LSC's Main Campus at 2101 Trinity Road; Duluth, MN 55811.
